What is 'White Card training' or a 'White Card'? White Card training is the term used to describe the general induction for construction training. This is a course of training that provides basic knowledge of construction work, the Work Health and Safety (WHS) Laws that apply, common hazards likely to be encountered in construction work, and how the associated risks can be controlled. 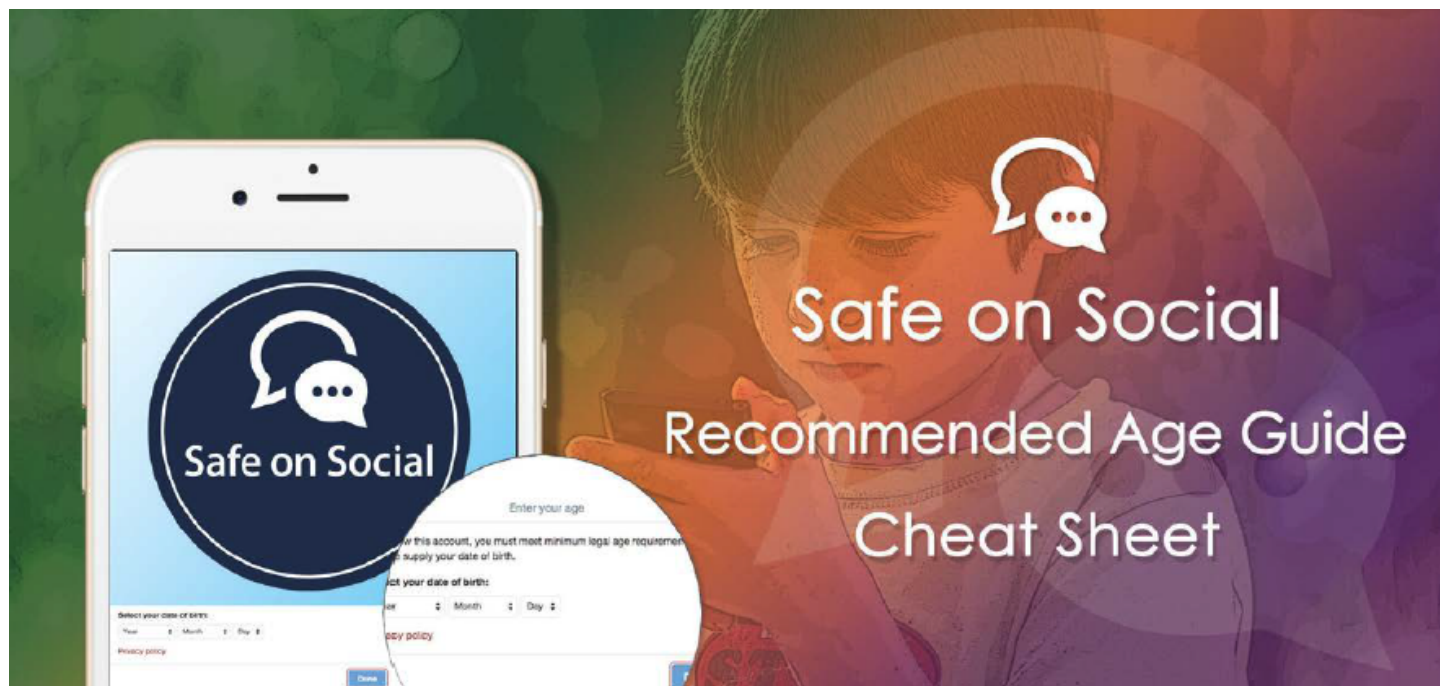
